***Disclaimer:***

Included in the classroom portion of Driver Education is information that will help you pass the knowledge test for a Class D Tennessee Driver License. Regardless of content and material covered during class you should obtain and read the most current version of the Tennessee Driver Study Guide, and it is suggested that you also obtain the Tennessee Driver Handbook that accompanies the study guide.

Most of the class work for this portion of class is objective (is obtained with definitive measurements)!

The driving portion of the class will consist of drill and practice of basic driving maneuvers.

Most of the class work and grades for the driving portion of class is subjective (is based on my observations and evaluations {aka.. my opinion} )!

**2<sup>nd</sup> Nine Weeks**

Driving = **100%**

Even if you drive during the 1<sup>st</sup> nine weeks, you driving grade will not be posted until the second nine weeks of the semester!

It is very important that you be present for the days you are scheduled to drive. It may be impossible to reschedule your driving time.

### Classroom Rules

- **Be On Time:**

Inside the classroom by the end of the late bell!!!

- **Have Proper Materials:**

Pen/Pencil, Paper, etc...

- **Respect Of Property:**

If it does not belong to you - LEAVE IT ALONE!!!
